Open the chest

Design scapes of Pudelskern in Milan

Six objects in company of six theoretical positions are the frame for the presentation of the Austrian design studio Pudelskern at the International Furniture Fair in Milan.

The six objects are a chest of drawers, a wardrobe, a coffee table, an acoustic panel, an easy chair and a rug. Pudelskern is in constant search for new or revived material and finds inspiration in handcraft-techniques. Natural material is the preferred choice - leather, wood, clay and wool of regional provenance. Another source for the ideas of the three designers from the mountainous Tyrol seem to be the landscapes of their surroundings.

In combination with the six written positions a landscape of design comes into existence. Dealing with topics of identity, beauty, repetition, approaches to projects and evolution of handcrafts the theoretical part is like a summary of the antecedent years since the team of Pudelskern started to work together.

Pudelskern is working internationally in interiors and product design. The studio was founded in 2006 in Innsbruck, Austria. The exhibition will take place from 14th to 19th of April, 2010, Salone Satellite, Booth B17, Fiera Milano Rho.
